| February 9 | King John sets sail for France with an army | |
| April 21 | Pope accepts over lordship of England and Ireland | |
| July 2 | Pope lifts the Interdict |  <i>Tomb of William Marshall</i> |
| July 27 | John's army is defeated heavily in the Battle of Bouvines | |
| October 13 | John returns to England and demands taxes from his subjects | |
| November 20 | Rebel barons meet in the Abbey at Bury St Edmunds | |

| January | Rebel barons ask John to confirm Henry's Charter. No answer given |  <i>Tomb of William Marshall</i> |
| May 5 | John rejects barons' demands. Civil war declared | |
| May 17 | Rebel barons capture much of London | |
| June 15 | John accepts the barons' demands at Runnymede and seals Magna Carta | |
| June 24 | First seven copies of Magna Carta are delivered for distribution | |
| August 24 | Pope annuls Magna Carta. Civil war again | |
| October | Rebel barons invite Prince Louis of France to depose John | |

| May | Louis invades England |  <i>Tomb of William Marshall</i> |
| October 18 | John dies at Newark and is buried in Worcester Cathedral | |
| November 12 | William Marshal issued revised version of Magna Carta | |

| November 6 | Second revision of Magna Carta issued by William Marshal |  <i>Tomb of William Marshall</i> |
| 1225 | | |
| 11 February | Third revision of Magna Carta issued under Great Seal of Henry III | |
| 1297 | | |
| 12 October | Edward I confirmed the 1225 version of Magna Carta: this confirmation was later placed on the first statute | |
